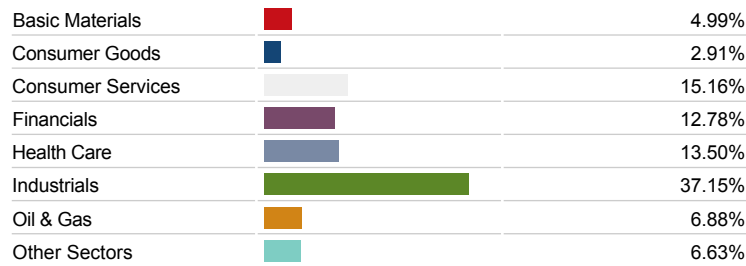

**Regional Allocation**



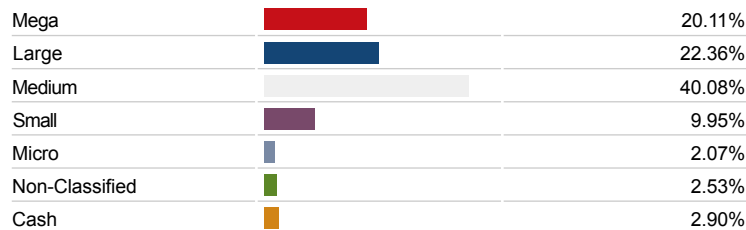
