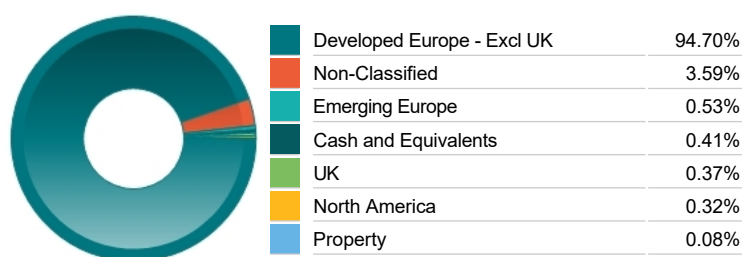

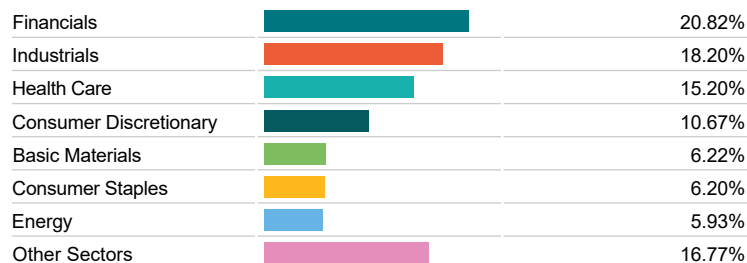

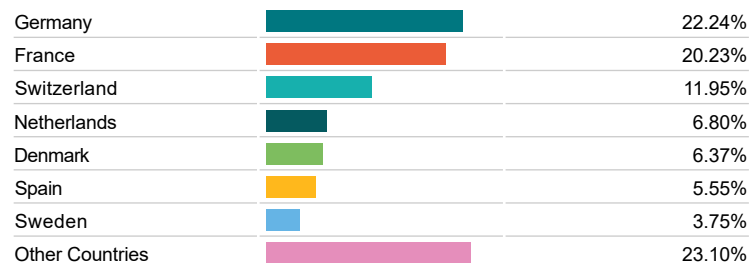
## Regional Allocation



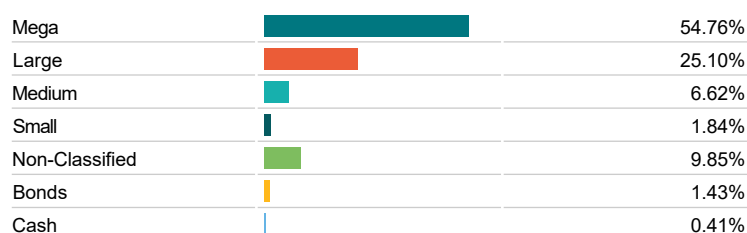
## Sector Breakdown



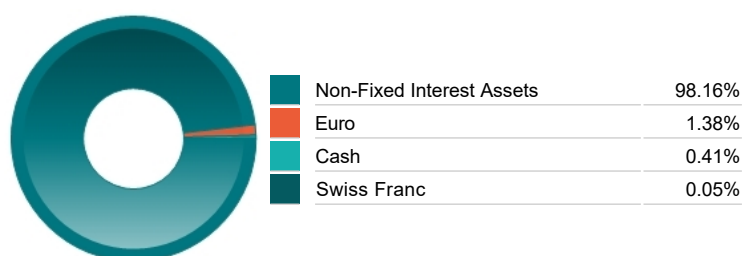
## Top Country Breakdown
