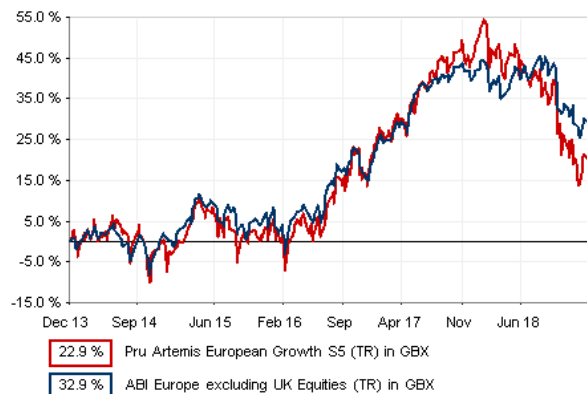

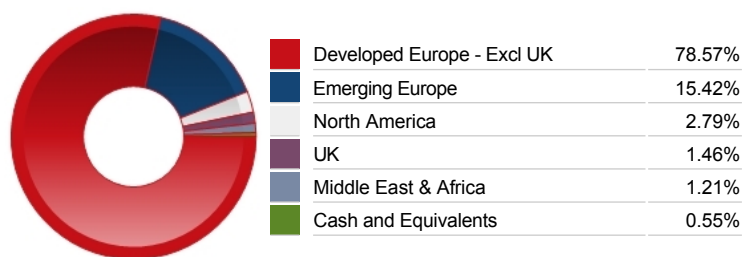

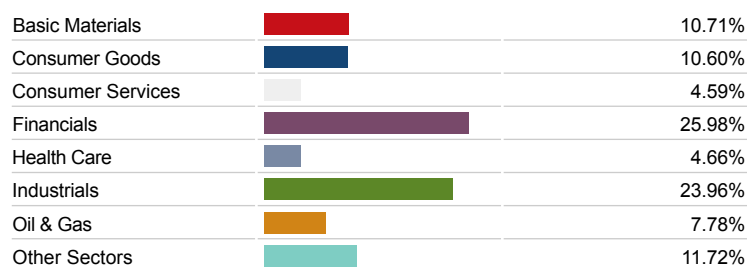
Asset Allocation



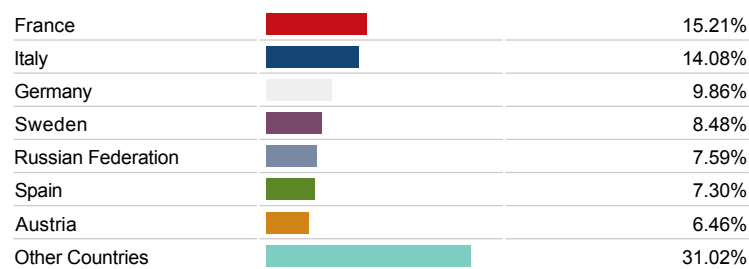
Regional Allocation



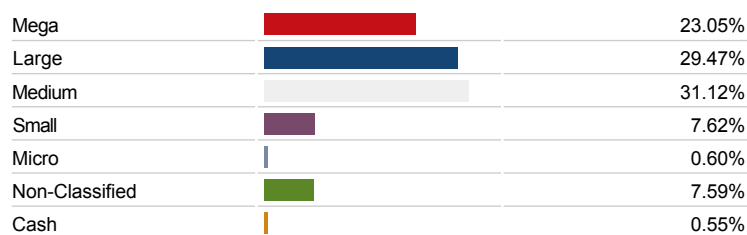
Equity Sector Breakdown



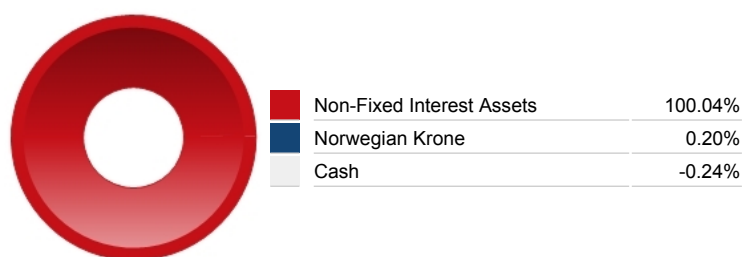
Top Country Breakdown
