Investment Objective

The Unicorn UK Income Fund aims to provide an income by investing in UK companies. UK companies are defined as those which are incorporated or domiciled in the UK, or have a significant part of their operations in the UK.

Investment Policy/Strategy

The Fund may also invest, at its discretion, in other transferable securities and deposits and cash. The Fund may also enter into certain derivative and forward transactions for hedging purposes.

The Fund invests at least 80% in UK companies which are quoted companies with a bias towards small and medium sized companies (those with a market value of less than £4 billion). Some of the companies in which the Fund invests may be quoted on AIM. AIM is the London Stock Exchange's international market for smaller, growing companies.

Fund Commentary

The UK Income Fund recorded a total return of -10.8% in September. This compares to the average total return of -7.1% from the IA UK Equity Income sector over the same period.

There were no major contributors over the period.

Notable contributors during the month included Conduit Holdings, which added +0.3% to overall Fund performance. The Company did not release any trading related news flow over September. Major detractors over the period included Londonmetric Property Plc, which cost -1.2% to overall Fund performance. Londonmetric did not release any trading related news flow during the period. Other notable detractors during the month included: Primary Health Properties and Phoenix Group Holdings, which both cost -0.8% in overall Fund performance terms. Primary Health Properties, one of the UK's leading investors in modern primary healthcare facilities, announced, that Ms Laure Duhot, a Non-executive director of the Company, has been appointed as a non-executive director of Orpea S.A, a Paris listed operator of retirement homes, outpatient and rehabilitation clinics, and psychiatric care. Phoenix Group did not release any trading

related news flow during the period.

Hill & Smith, Schroders and Breedon Group were added to the Fund during the month, while positions in Appreciate and Chesnara were exited.
