INVESTMENT STRATEGY

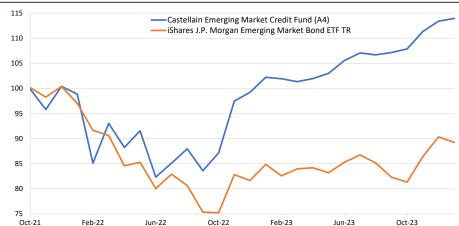
The strategy is focused on USD and EUR denominated emerging market sovereign credit. The strategy is long biased but utilises both long and short credit positions to capture relative value opportunities. Hedging strategies are employed to reduce interestrate exposure and tail risks. There is a strong preference for liquid assets.

COMMENTARY

The Castellain Emerging Market Credit Fund returned 0.5% in January, outperforming the J.P. Morgan Emerging Market Bond ETF (EMB) which returned -1.2% on the month.

Developed market interest volatility was a key theme across 2023, and 2024 started in a similar fashion. US Treasury 10-year yields moved from 3.88% to 4.18% before falling back to close the month at 3.91%. This interest rate volatility paved the way for a turbulent month for the Emerging Market asset class. Despite the weak macro backdrop, there was a significant supply of primary issuance in the sovereign space, which was well received, but this did put further pressure on existing bond prices, which results in bond spreads widening. The average spread of EM bonds within the EMB Index moved from 319bps to 336bps over the course of the month.
