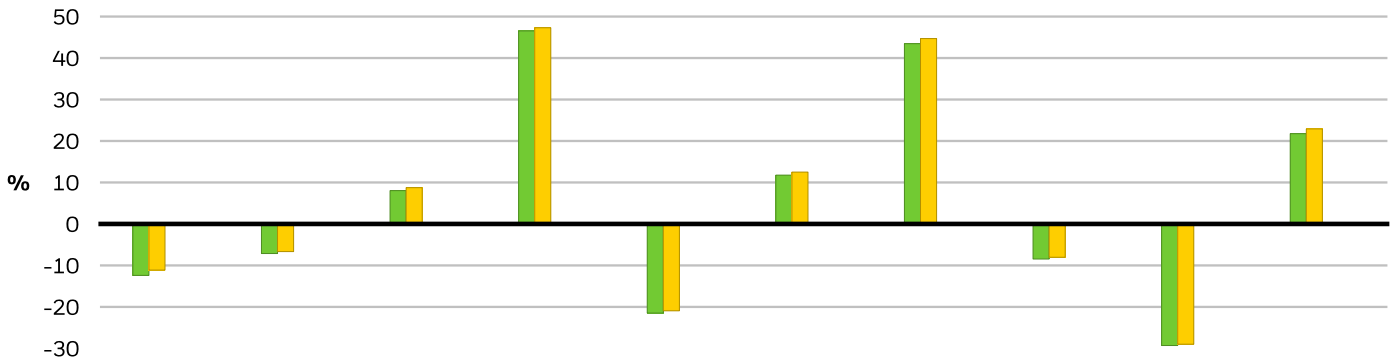

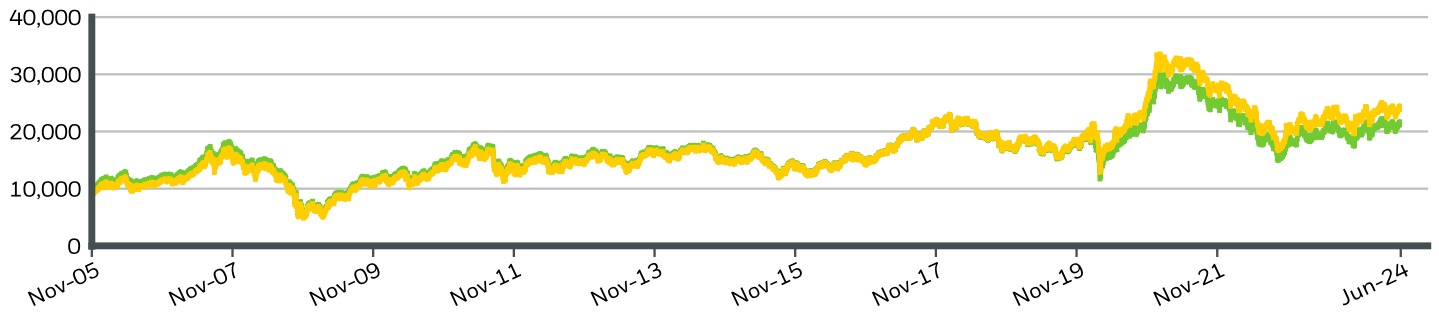

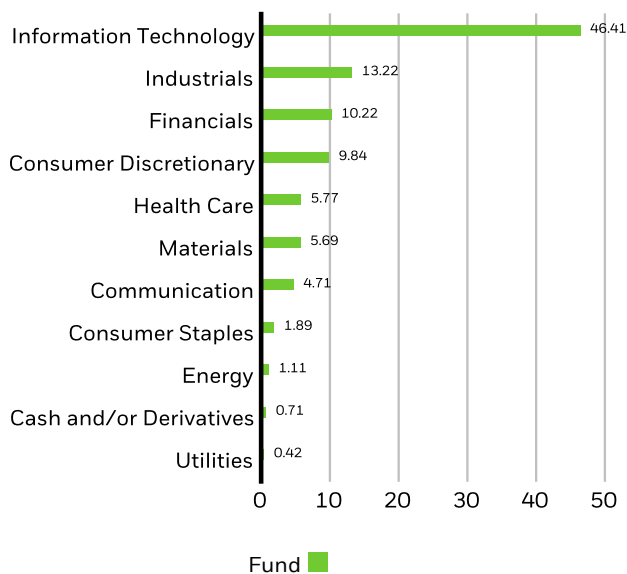

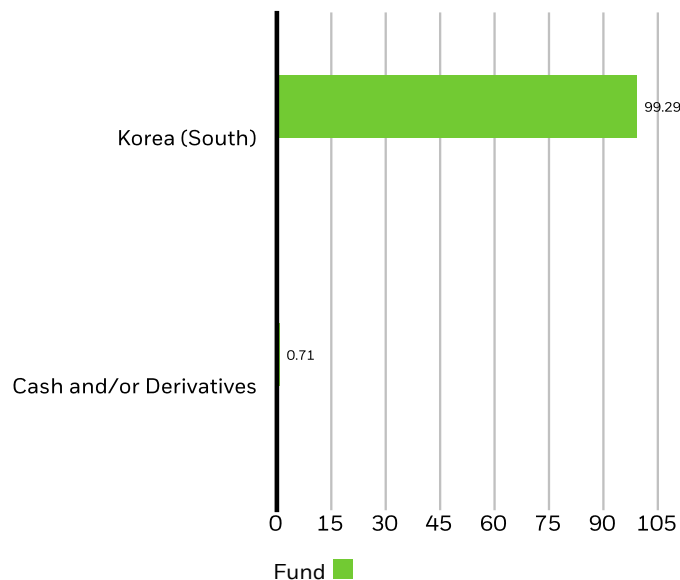

#### GLOSSARY
