This Fund is managed by Investment Fund Services Limited (IFSL)

Objectives and Investment Policy

The aim of the Fund is to grow the value of your investment over a period of at least 5 years. This growth is expected to come from a combination of profit on investments and income paid out of investments, such as interest and dividends.

The Fund is actively managed which means the Investment Manager decides which investments to buy or sell, and when.

At least 70% of the Fund will be invested in other funds, including exchange traded funds and investment trusts. This may include other funds managed by the Authorised Corporate Director or Investment Manager. The Fund will be managed on a higher risk strategy, and through these other funds gain exposure to between 70-100% in the shares of companies.

Up to 30% of the Fund will be exposed to bonds, which are loans typically issued by companies and governments. This may include investment grade bonds, where the issuer has a higher capacity to repay the debt, as well as sub-investment grade bonds, which can be more vulnerable to changing market conditions but typically pay a higher rate of interest.

The Fund may also have exposure to other assets, such as: • up to 20% in money market instruments, which are shorter term loans. • property and commodities, such as gold and oil up to a maximum of 30%. Although the Fund will have exposure to no more than 10% in any one commodity type or physical property.

The Fund may also gain exposure to the above asset classes through investing directly (other than in respect of property or commodities).

Investments will cover a range of global markets, with no more than 30% of the Fund being invested in emerging or frontier markets.

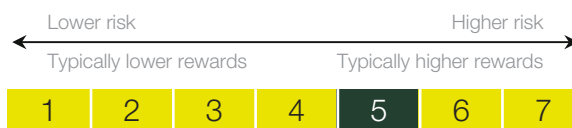
The Fund may use derivatives and structured products (instruments whose returns are linked to another asset or other variable factor such as exchange rates or stock markets) for the purposes of efficient portfolio management (including hedging) and for meeting the investment objectives of the Fund. The Fund will not always hold these instruments however at times they may be held for extended periods. Derivatives may be used to increase or decrease market or currency exposure. It is expected the use of derivatives will not have a significant impact on the risk profile of the Fund. The Fund may also invest in other funds which are permitted to use derivatives to varying degrees.

The Fund will hold up to 20% in cash to enable the ready settlement of liabilities (including redemptions) and for the efficient management of the Fund.

The Investment Association (IA), the trade body for UK investment managers, has created a number of 'sectors' as a way of dividing funds into broad groups with similar characteristics. The Fund's investment policy puts it in the IA Flexible Investment sector. You may want to assess the Fund's performance compared to the performance of this sector. From time to time, due to the nature of the IA Flexible Investment sector, the Fund may have an asset allocation which is different to the average of the sector. This variable nature of the sector should be taken into consideration when comparing the performance of the Fund

The Fund pays income. If you wish to receive this please tell us. If you do not want to receive income you will be given accumulation shares which means income is invested back into the Fund and reflected in the price of your shares. You can buy or sell all or part of your investment on any business day subject to the minimum holding requirements.

Risk and Reward Profile

This Fund has been measured as 5 because its investments have experienced moderate to high volatility in the past.

As at 21 April 2023 the Fund changed its investment policy, therefore this rating may change as the result of the portfolio realignment.

The Fund's volatility is affected by various risks, including:

- The Fund will be exposed to stock markets and market conditions can change rapidly. Prices can move irrationally and be affected unpredictably by diverse factors, including political and economic events.
- The Fund has exposure to bonds, the prices of which will be impacted by factors including; changes in interest rates, inflation expectations and perceived credit quality. When interest rates rise, bond values generally fall. This risk is generally greater for longer term bonds and for bonds with perceived lower credit quality.
- The Fund invests in other currencies. Changes in exchange rates will therefore affect the value of your investment.
- The Fund has or may at times have a concentrated portfolio which means

greater exposure to a smaller number of securities than a diversified portfolio. This means the performance of a single stock in the portfolio has a greater effect on the price of the Fund.

Risks which are not adequately captured by the risk indicator include:

- Bonds that produce a higher level of income carry greater risk that the issuer will not be able to pay the income or repay the capital at maturity.
- In certain market conditions some assets may be less predictable than usual. This may make it harder to sell at a desired price and/or in a timely manner. In extreme market conditions redemptions in the underlying funds or the Fund itself may be deferred or suspended.
- The insolvency of any institution providing services, such as safekeeping of assets or holding investments with returns linked to financial contracts (known as derivatives), may expose the Fund to financial loss.
- The Fund may enter into various financial contracts (known as derivatives) in an attempt to protect the value of the Fund's assets, to reduce the costs of investing or for investment purposes. There is however a risk that the desired result may not be achieved or may result in gains or losses greater than the amount originally invested.
- The Fund's cash may be deposited with various financial institutions. The Fund may suffer a loss if these institutions fail to make its payments or become insolvent.

Charges

The charges you pay are used to pay the costs of running the Fund, including the costs of marketing and distributing it. These charges reduce the potential growth of your investment. The entry and exit charges shown are maximum figures. In some cases you may pay less - you can find this out from your financial adviser.

As at 21 April 2023 the Fund changed its investment policy, therefore the ongoing charges figure shown is an estimate intended to reflect the portfolio realignment. This figure may vary from year to year. It excludes:

- Portfolio transaction costs, except in the case of an entry/exit charge paid by the UCITS when buying or selling units in another collective investment undertaking.

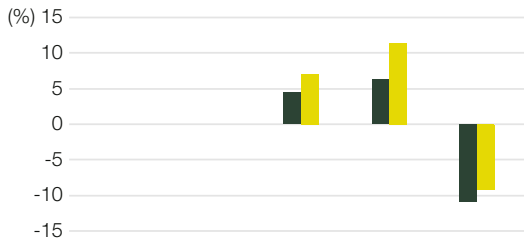
