The authorised fund manager of the Fund is Legal & General (Unit Trust Managers) Limited (the "Manager").

OBJECTIVES AND INVESTMENT POLICY

- The objective of the Fund is to track the performance of the MSCI World SRI Index, the "Benchmark Index" on a net total return basis before fees and expenses are applied. Fund performance may differ from the Benchmark Index due to the deduction of fees and expenses and the impact of any tracking error factors.
- The Fund replicates the Benchmark Index as closely as possible by holding all, or substantially all, of its constituents in a similar proportion to their weightings in the Benchmark Index.
- The Benchmark Index is comprised of shares in large and middle capitalisation shares in companies across various developed markets and it is constructed with an aim to represent the performance of companies that are consistent with specific norms-based (screening against minimum standards of business practice based on international norms), sector based, and/or values-based exclusions, climate change-based criteria and that have high environmental, social and governance ("ESG") ratings relative to their sector peers.
- The Fund will generally hold assets directly but can use depositary receipts (such as American depositary receipts and global depositary receipts) to gain exposure such as when the direct asset cannot be held or is not available.
- The Fund may also invest in shares in companies which are reasonably expected to become part of the Benchmark Index in the near future or are an alternative to a constituent of the Benchmark Index, money market instruments (such as treasury bills), depositary receipts, cash, deposits and collective investment schemes including those managed or operated by the Manager or an associate of the Manager.
- The Benchmark Index provider excludes certain companies, as set out in their methodology, including companies involved in nuclear power, tobacco, alcohol, gambling, conventional and controversial weapons, civilian firearms, genetically modified organisms, thermal coal power, fossil fuel reserves ownership, fossil fuel extraction and adult entertainment. - The Benchmark Index provider is also designed to select the top 25% of companies across sectors and industries according to their MSCI ESG Ratings. ESG scores are translated into 'AAA' to 'CCC' scale, indicating a company's exposure to industry material ESG issues and their ability to manage those issues relative to industry peers. A rating of 'AAA' for example

represents a company that is a leader in its industry managing the most significant ESG issues and opportunities. A rating of 'CCC' comparatively represents a company lagging behind its industry peers, based on its high exposure, and failure to manage significant ESG issues.

- ESG issues vary by sector but consist of, amongst other things, carbon emissions, health and safety, business ethics and biodiversity. - The Fund does not apply a UK sustainability investment label in accordance with the FCA's Sustainability Disclosure Requirements.

- The Fund may use derivatives (financial contracts which have a value linked to the price of another financial asset (such as a share, bond or currency) or a market index) in order to:

Other information:

- The Fund is passively managed as it tracks the Benchmark Index.
- Your units will be accumulation units. Income from the Fund's investments (dividends) will be reinvested back into the value of your units.
- You can buy or sell units in this Fund on any business day. You need to contact us with your instruction before 3pm. This is the time we calculate unit prices for this Fund. If you contact us after 3pm, the units will be bought or sold at the next business day's price.
- The Fund's base currency is denominated in GBP.
- This Fund may be suitable for investors looking to invest in Global company shares that confirm to a range of Ethical and Environmental guidelines.
- Although investors can take their money out at any time, this Fund may not be appropriate for those who plan to withdraw their money within five years.
- This Fund is not designed for investors who cannot afford more than a minimal loss of their investment.
- If you do not understand this document we recommend you seek additional information to help you decide if this Fund is right for you.

RISK AND REWARD PROFILE

- The Fund has a sustainability and/or ESG focus in its investment process which may i) limit the Fund's exposure to or exclude certain companies, industries or sectors ii) impact the Fund's investment performance compared to other funds that do not apply such criteria and, iii) differ from an investor's own sustainability and/or ESG criteria.
- The Fund may have underlying investments that are valued in currencies that are different from GBP. Exchange rate fluctuations will impact the value of your investment. Currency hedging techniques may be applied to reduce this impact but may not entirely eliminate it.

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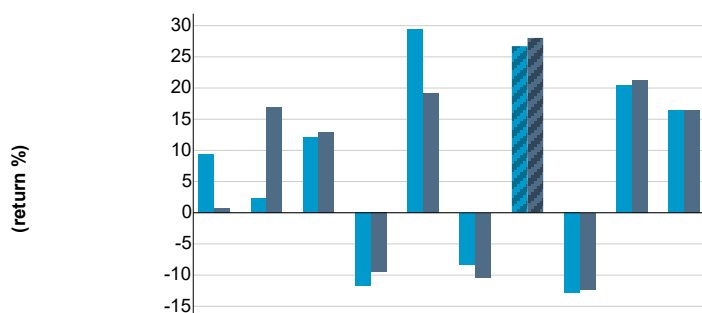
- There are no entry or exit charges.
- The ongoing charges figure is based on the latest available expenses at December 2024. This figure may vary from year to year.
- This Fund's ongoing charges include any charges made by any other funds it may invest in. They exclude portfolio transaction costs.
- The ongoing charges are taken from the Income of the Fund.

Other costs:

- **Dilution adjustment:** On any day, the prices for buying or selling units in this Fund are the same. The Fund manager calculates a single price for this Fund based on the mid-point between the buying and selling prices of the Fund's assets. In certain circumstances, the Fund manager can adjust this price to account for whether there is more money going into or coming out of the Fund. This is called a 'dilution adjustment'.
- This can vary but as an example for this Fund we estimate 0.06% for purchases and 0.15% for sales at 31 December 2024. The amount of the dilution adjustment may differ in future.
