OBJECTIVES AND INVESTMENT POLICY

Objective

• The Fund aims to provide income while also growing your investment by outperforming, net of fees, the ICE BofA Sterling Non-Gilt Index over 3 years or more.

Main Investments

• At least 80% of the Fund's investments will be in fixed income securities (e.g. bonds).

Investment Policy

- To invest in bonds, including covered bonds, debentures and securitised debt issued by companies located globally, either in Sterling or hedged back to Sterling. The fund may also invest in non-Sterling denominated fixed interest securities; money market instruments including money market funds and UK government bonds.
- The fund may also invest up to 20% of its value in government bonds, bonds not issued in Sterling, cash and cash equivalents.

Other Information

- The Fund may invest up to 20% of its assets in other fixed income securities that do not meet the above criteria, for example on-Sterling denominated fixed interest securities, money market instruments (whether sterling denominated or not), or UK gilts.
- With a view to enhancing returns and/or as part of the investment strategy, the Fund may make use of derivatives for efficient portfolio management (including hedging) purposes.
- The Fund uses the ICE Bank of America Sterling Non-Gilt Index as a target benchmark and to measure performance.
- The Fund may invest more than 35% in fixed income securities issued by a single state, local authority, or public international body.
- Income will be included in the value of your shares.

Buying and selling shares

 Investors may buy or sell shares on any London working day, or any other day if decided by the ACD.
