Fund manager's report

- European high yield had another strong month of total returns, despite the rally slowing in pace. Primary market supply picked up with €4.8bn issued, bringing the year-to-date total to €9.4bn, down 40% on last year.
- The European Central Bank and US Federal Reserve continued to be dovish, providing comfort to markets. Data from the Eurozone shows persistent weakness, demonstrated by auto sector profit warnings from BMW and Schaeffler. G3 bond yields fell sharply.
- The first quarter of 2019 has proven to be one of the strongest quarters for asset class returns in recent history. The Brexit impasse continued, yet sterling related assets displayed little concern.
