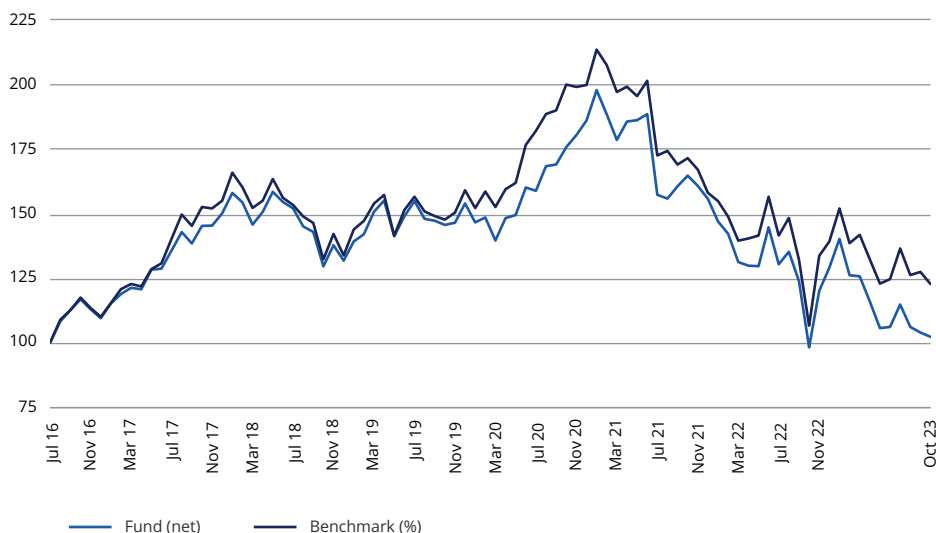
Objective

The Fund aims to provide long term growth by investing in the Chinese equity market. The Fund aims to outperform the MSCI China Index (USD) benchmark before charges.

Portfolio securities

- The Fund seeks to achieve this objective by investing at least 70% in equities and equity related securities of corporations domiciled in The People's Republic of China or companies that derive a significant proportion of their revenues or profits from Chinese operations or have a significant proportion of their assets there.
- This may include equities that are listed domestically or overseas or investment in companies with variable interest Entity (VIE) structures to gain exposure to industries with foreign ownership restrictions.
- The Fund may invest up to 50% of its net assets in Mainland China equity and equity-related securities including through the Shanghai-Hong Kong and Shenzhen-Hong Kong Stock Connect programme or by any other available means.

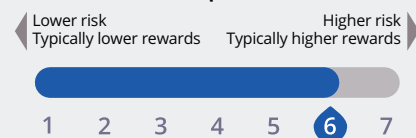

- The Fund is actively managed.
- The benchmark is used as a reference point for portfolio construction and as a basis for setting risk constraints.
