Investment Objective

The Fund aims to maximise total return, consistent with preservation of capital and prudent investment management, by aiming to outperform (net of fees) the FTSE Actuaries UK Conventional Gilts All Stocks Index Midday Total Return (in GBP), over a rolling three year period. It invests directly in gilts (being UK government bonds), overseas government bonds, government guaranteed bonds and supranational bonds. At least 80% of the value of the Fund will be invested in gilts issued by the United Kingdom Government. Please see the Key Investor Information Document for objectives and investment policy.






