



Square Mile Research rating as at 31 March 2021.

A Square Mile Fund Rating denotes a fund that is truly "best in class". Put simply, a Square Mile Fund Rating is only given to a fund that we are prepared to recommend to our clients. Fund managers do not pay for our ratings; they cannot be purchased and are only achieved by the "best-in-class" funds.

The funds we recommend are each assigned a rating – A, AA, AAA or R – reflecting Square Mile's conviction in each fund's ability to deliver on expectations. These simple ratings are the result of exhaustive and detailed qualitative research, backed up by quantitative analysis. Our team of investment research analysts also works to identify newer or untested funds or managers that have real potential to deliver their stated objectives. In these circumstances, we are not in a position to award a full fund rating, and therefore these funds are assigned a "Positive Prospects" rating. Over time, if these managers deliver to our expectations and achieve their expected outcome, we would expect them to progress to A, AA, AAA or R ratings. Not widely used.

They have three key ratings: Established; Positive Watch; Recommended. **Quartile ranking** measures how well a fund has performed in the relevant Morningstar sector. 1st quartile means ranked in the top 25% of funds in the sector, 2nd quartile is the next 25% and so on.

Correlation measures the relationship between the movement of the fund and its benchmark. A correlation of 1.00 indicates that the fund perfectly matched its benchmark.

Alpha (%) a measure of excess return generated by a manager compared to the benchmark. An alpha of 1.00 indicates that a fund has outperformed its benchmark by 1%.

Beta a measure of a fund's sensitivity to market movements (as represented by the fund's benchmark). A beta of 1.10 suggests the fund could perform 10% better than the benchmark in up markets and 10% worse in down markets, assuming all other factors remain constant.

Annualised volatility (%) an absolute measure of volatility and measures the extent to which returns vary up and down over a given period. High volatility means that the returns have been more variable over time. The measure is expressed as an annualised value.

Sharpe ratio measures the performance of an investment adjusting for the amount of risk taken (compared a risk-free investment). The higher the Sharpe ratio the better the returns compared to the risk taken.
