Objectives and Investment Policy

FTF Templeton Global Emerging Markets Fund (the "Fund") aims to grow in value by more than the MSCI Emerging Markets (Net Dividends) Index (the "Index") over a five-year period after all fees and costs are deducted.

The Fund invests at least two thirds (but typically significantly more) in emerging markets (that is countries whose economy and financial markets are still developing).

The Fund typically invests in around 70 to 90 companies of any size or industry that:

- are listed on an emerging markets stock exchange; or
- are domiciled or conduct a significant proportion of their business in emerging markets; or
- receive a significant amount of their revenues from emerging markets.

To a lesser extent the Fund may invest in frontier markets.

There may be overlap with the Index but it does not intend to replicate it and may include shares and countries not included in the Index.

Exposure in a single company will be in a range of 5 % more or less than the

Index.

Typical country exposure in a range of 10 % more or less than the Index.

The Fund may invest to a lesser extent in other asset classes.

The Fund can use derivatives for efficient portfolio management (that is managing the Fund in a way that is designed to reduce risk or cost and/or generate extra income or growth).

You may request the sale of your shares on any UK business day.

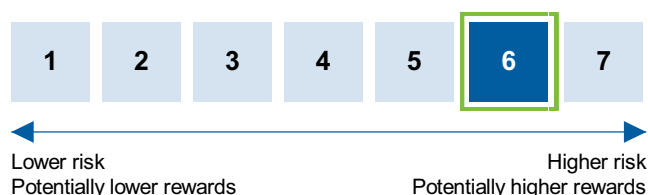
The income received from the Fund's investments is accumulated and included in the value of the shares.

Why is the Fund in this specific category?

The Fund invests mainly in the equity and equity-related securities of emerging

markets around the world that have historically been subject to significant price movements, frequently to a greater extent than equity markets globally. As a result, the performance of the Fund can fluctuate significantly over relatively short time periods.

Risks materially relevant not adequately captured by the indicator:

Foreign Currency risk: the risk of loss arising from exchange-rate fluctuations or due to exchange control regulations.

Emerging markets risk: the risk related to investing in countries that have less developed political, economic, legal and regulatory systems, and that may be impacted by political/economic instability, lack of liquidity or transparency, or safekeeping issues.

Liquidity risk: the risk that arises when adverse market conditions affect the ability to sell assets when necessary. Reduced liquidity may have a negative impact on the price of the assets.

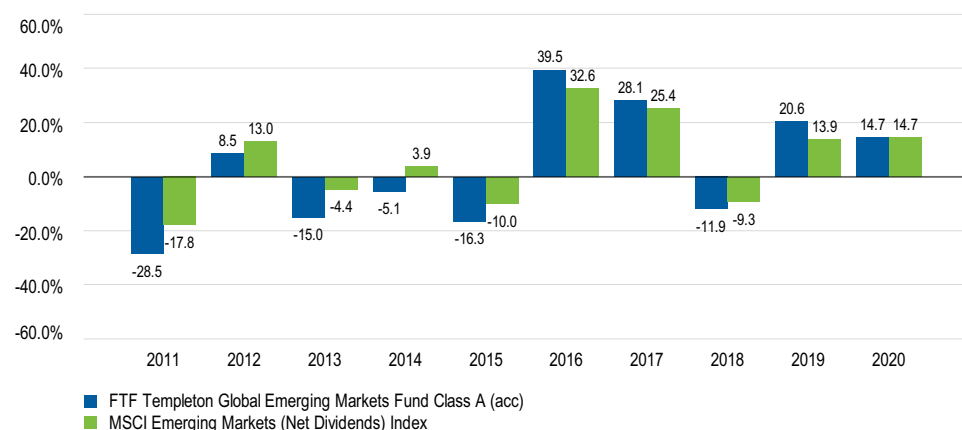
