Objective and Investment Policy

Investment Objective

The aim of this Fund is to provide medium to long-term capital growth with a return (net of fees) greater than the MSCI Europe ex-UK Index (the "Index") on a rolling three to five year basis. The return of the Index is subject to the performance of the relevant stock market and therefore the Fund may not provide capital growth in all market conditions.

Investment Policy

The MSCI Europe ex-UK Index is designed to measure the performance of the shares of companies listed on stock exchanges in developed European countries (excluding the UK).

The Fund is actively managed. The Fund invests in a diversified portfolio of shares of large and medium sized companies in all industry sectors which are listed on European stock exchanges (excluding those in the UK). The Fund manager uses a proprietary stock selection model to identify companies that it believes to be attractive, relative to their industry peers, based on the model's analysis of their financial data. In constructing the Fund's portfolio, the Fund manager references the index which means that, while the Fund manager has discretion to select the investments for the Fund, the Fund's divergence from the index is controlled.

The Fund may use derivatives (financial instruments that derive their value from the value of other assets) in an attempt to reduce the overall risk of its investments, reduce the costs of investing or generate additional capital or income known as Efficient Portfolio Management (EPM).

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
