Objectives and Investment Policy

OBJECTIVE

To achieve long-term capital appreciation through investing primarily (meaning at least three quarters of the Fund's total assets) in a portfolio of equity and equity related securities of companies located throughout the world.

POLICY

The Fund will:

- invest anywhere in the world;
- invest in company shares and similar investments;
- select investments using fundamental analysis including evaluation of balance sheet strength. For each investment in the portfolio, the investment manager will complete an evaluation on environmental (pollution and waste management), human and social capital (conduct and culture, bribery and corruption) and governance (board independence, shareholder protection) considerations. All investments will have to adhere to the Investment Manager's environmental, social and governance ("ESG") criteria;
- promote environmental and social characteristics pursuant to Article 8 of the Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation ("SFDR"); and
- invest at least 5% of its Net Asset Value (NAV) in companies that meet the definition of sustainable investments under SFDR and exclude companies that participate in specific areas of activity that the Investment Manager deems to be harmful from an

environmental or social perspective. All companies in which investments are made follow good governance practices.

The Fund may:

- invest up to 20% of its Net Asset Value (NAV) in emerging markets;
- invest up to 10% of its Net Asset Value (NAV) in collective investment schemes; and
- use derivatives (financial instruments whose value is derived from other assets) with the aim of risk or cost reduction or to generate additional capital or income.

Benchmark: The Fund will measure its performance against the MSCI World NR Index (the "Benchmark").

The Fund is actively managed, which means the Investment Manager has absolute discretion to invest outside the Benchmark subject to the investment objective and policies disclosed in the Prospectus. While the Fund's holdings may include constituents of the Benchmark, the selection of investments and their weightings in the portfolio are not influenced by the Benchmark. The investment strategy does not restrict the extent to which the Investment Manager may deviate from the Benchmark.

OTHER INFORMATION

Treatment of income: net income generated will be retained within the Fund and reflected in the value of your shares.

Dealing: you can buy and sell your shares in the Fund between 9:00 and 17:00 (Irish Time) on each day which is a business day in Ireland and the U.S. Instructions received before 12:00 will receive the price quoted on that day. The minimum initial investment for this share class is GBP 15,000,000.

We have calculated the risk and reward indicator, as shown above. It is based on the rate at which the value of the Fund has moved up and down in the past (i.e. volatility). This Fund is rated 6 because its historical value has shown relatively high volatility. With a Fund rating of 6, you have a relatively high risk of losing money but your chance for gains is also relatively high.

Real Estate Investment Trust (REITs) Risk: The Fund is subject to risks associated with investing in real estate which may include but is not limited to liquidity constraints arising from difficulties with the disposal of the underlying properties, fluctuations in the value of underlying properties, defaults by borrowers or tenants, market saturation, changes in general and local economic conditions, decreases in market rates for rents, increases in competition, property taxes, capital expenditures or operating expenses and other economic, political or regulatory occurrences affecting companies in the real estate industry.

Geographic Concentration Risk: Where the Fund invests significantly in a single market, this may have a material impact on the value of the Fund.

Objective/Performance Risk: There is no guarantee that the Fund will achieve its objectives.

Currency Risk: This Fund invests in international markets which means it is exposed to changes in currency rates which could affect the value of the Fund.

Derivatives Risk: Derivatives are highly sensitive to changes in the value of the asset from which their value is derived. A small movement in the value of the underlying asset can cause a large movement in the value of the derivative. This can increase the sizes of losses and gains, causing the value of your investment to fluctuate. When using derivatives, the Fund can lose significantly more than the amount it has invested in derivatives.

Emerging Markets Risk: Emerging Markets have additional risks due to less-developed market practices.

Share Class Currency Risk: This share class is denominated in a different currency from the base currency of the Fund. Changes in the exchange rate between the share class currency and the base currency may affect the value of your investment.

Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) Investment Approach Risk: The Fund follows an ESG investment approach. This means factors other than financial performance are considered as part of the investment process. This carries the risk that the Fund's performance may be negatively impacted due to restrictions placed on its exposure to certain sectors or types of investments. The approach taken may not reflect the opinions of any particular investor. In addition, in following an ESG investment approach, the Fund is dependent upon information and data from third parties (which may include providers for research reports, screenings, ratings and/or analysis such as index providers and consultants). Such information or data may be incomplete, inaccurate or inconsistent.

Counterparty Risk: The insolvency of any institutions providing services such as custody of assets or acting as a counterparty to derivatives or other contractual arrangements, may expose the Fund to financial loss.

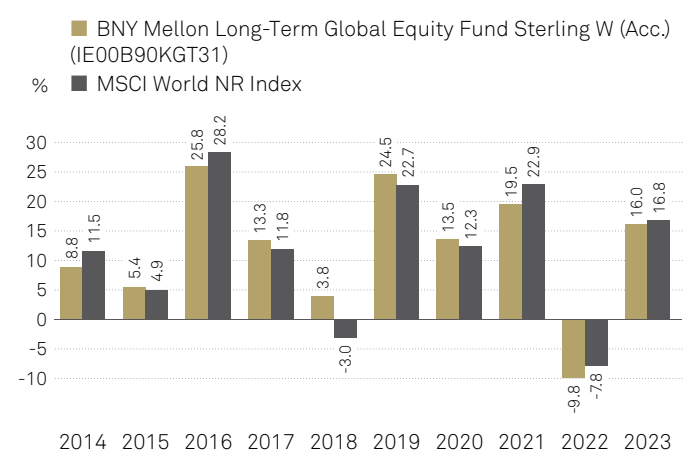
The entry charge shown is a maximum figure but you may pay less. The actual entry charge can be obtained from your financial adviser or distributor.
